POSITION PURPOSE: Under the supervision of the Pump Project manager load and deliver material to pump installations at jobsites.

## **ESSENTIAL DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- 1. Deliver material as specified by supervisor on truck and trailer to jobsites or customer locations.
- 2. Collect finished and raw goods from vendors and return to yard when required.
- 3. Responsible for securing and unloading cargo from vehicle.
- 4. Able to use basic electric skills to ensure safe correct installations when required.
- 5. Able to communicate effectively with customers & fellow employees.
- 6. Available for cellphone contact at all times with supervisor to receive ongoing instructions.
- 7. Record clean & accurate freight documentation, work orders, purchase orders, sales orders & packing list.
- 8. Assist in loading & unloading truck manually when required.
- 9. Be proficient in the tie-down & securing of cargo.
- 10. Wear CALWEST RAIN uniform during work hours representing the company in a polite & professional manner at all times.
- 11. Clean & wash vehicle as required to promote safety, efficiency & CALWEST RAIN
- 12. Daily Inspection (DI) of truck & trailer is a mandatory requirement of the position, reporting any required repairs immediately to your supervisor.
- 13. Report any jobsite or traffic incidents to supervisor immediately.
- 14. Be aware & comply with MSDS (material safety data sheets) on items carried on your vehicle.
- 15. Ensure all rest breaks are taken and documented on time card.
- 16. Must learn the OSHA hand signals for coordinating crane boom movements

MANAGEMENT RESPONSIBILITIES: Supervise a helper and take control when operating the crane of all individuals in the area.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS: To hold this position successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily.

EDUCATION AND/OR EXPERIENCE: Must hold a clean Class A driving license. Able to navigate with minimal assistance.

LANGUAGE SKILLS: Ability to understand and document project details on company paperwork & electronic media.
